JENNY REDI MADE broke sharp, soon got clear, headed in the turn, fought back and regained the advantage toward the inside turning for home, long drive, proved narrowly best in a determined effort. MACHO MAMA in the second flight early while off the inside, moved up and challenged between foes and three wide turning for home, fell back off the winner a bit inside the furlong marker, trying to come back final strides, too late to be outfinished. BLACKBERRY KISSES forwardly placed, moved up to put a head in front outside the winner turn, weakened in the drive, narrowly held the show. C'MERE LUCY off the pace, came three wide into the stretch, asked for run, angled in with less than a furlong remaining, missed the show. CELEBRATION R N void of early foot, moved out to be four wide out of the turn, improved a bit but lacked a significant late response while remaining well out in the strip. NORTHERN GHOST forwardly placed, faltered three wide. SONGFROMTHEHEART steadied start, saved ground through the turn while well back, slight steady while continuing inside entering the stretch, picked off a couple of tiring foes. SHE SAID WHAT tired through the stretch while in traffic. MY PLEASURE ZONE chased early, staged a steady retreat. FENOM trailed throughout while far back.

COLE'S MUSIC broke in a bit, quickly cleared, continued to show the way into the turn, vied into the lane closest to the inside, edged clear again late. DOYLINE BUBBA within striking distance, loomed a threat four wide turning for home, dueled with the winner outside that one past the furlong marker, could not keep up late. REGENCY SQUARE forwardly placed while along the inside, continued just off the pace upper stretch, lacked a winning response. SCORE TO SETTLE void of early foot, moved out when straightened for home looking for room, late run to improve position, finished up willingly. MYFRIENDROYAL jostled at the start, moved up behind the first group, fanned five wide turning for home, went evenly through the stretch. FORTYNINE LANDING prompted the pace from the outside, continued to race within striking distance into the lane, had little left the final furlong. TIME TO RULE between foes while off the pace, lacked a closing response. BOUNDARY ZONE lacked speed, dropped inside for the turn, saved ground to no avail. ASSISTANT K J tired while four wide through the turn. BID MY VALENTINE reared at the start, trailed, picked off a couple of tiring foes. IDESEYOUINHOUSTON tired in the three path. IMPERIAL DEELITE five out to seven wide into and through the turn, finished far back.

SPEEDACIOUS pinched at the start, moved up steadily to be a forward factor before a quarter, vied between foes turn, drew away through the stretch under steady handling. LEE CITY void of early foot, swung out when asked to be six wide into the stretch, finished willingly down the middle of the strip to be up for the place. LA RASKA settled in the early going off the inside and well off the pace, angled out four wide turning for home, also showed some late interest and was up for the show. GOOD HUMAN BEAN pressured the pace while out in the strip for three furlongs, weakened. DAWN'S TRIBUTE moved off the inside late in the turn, lacked a late kick.
