AIR COMBAT behind the leaders while off the inside, continued to stalk through the turn, moved out, upper stretch, three wide bid past the furlong marker, gained the advantage and drew clear while attempting to lug in. CAGEY closest to the early leader, engaged that one and dueled through the turn while off the inside, vied between foes midstretch, could not match the winner late, second best. PAPERS TO PROVE IT set the pace along the inside, dueled through the turn, gained a larger lead once again when straightened for home, faltered in the final furlong. SALSORICE behind the pace, raced three wide and outside the winner into lane, bothered slightly by that rival three sixteenths out, finished up evenly. BIRD STORM lacked speed, came five wide out of the turn when beginning a tepid rally, improved position a bit while continuing outside. DRAINMAKERLUVSYOU settled off the early pace while in some traffic, little in the way of a response in the drive. TYEE lacked speed, shuffled back in traffic a half mile out, not involved thereafter. SORTA AFFAIRS tired from early efforts. SKY ART forwardly placed in the early going, began to retreat before a half. BACK UP PLAN last to leave, trailed throughout, finished far back.

RODEO MISS forwardly placed, moved to challenge on the outside with a middle move turning for home, could not keep up the final furlong. LOLA'S SURPRISE lacked early foot outside, came four wide into the stretch, roused, mild rally to be getting to the runner up late. BETSY LAVERNE void of early foot, raced in some traffic while four wide exiting the turn, improved position while not a serious threat to the top three. GITTIN COZY forwardly placed in the early going, fell back a bit into the turn, went evenly in the drive. TRIBUTE TO JUDY turned in an evenly paced effort throughout while off the inside. STRIKE HAPPY close early, moved up to challenge between the top two turning for home, faltered soon after. DOLLAR COTTON five wide out of the turn, failed to rally. CAT WICK last away, passed tiring rivals. PEPPERMINT MARY bumped start, no threat. ADDI GIRL just behind leader, steadied into the turn along the inside, fell back, no threat. MY BRIANNA five then six wide turn, faded through the stretch, well beaten.

CAN'T COMPLAIN forwardly placed from the start while off the inside, challenged three wide turn, steadily clear through the stretch while being kept to task. CY'S HOPE outrun in the early going, improved into the turn, roused late in the bend, finished up willingly to earn the place while no threat to the winner. SADIE'S SOLDIER devoid of speed for a half, angled out from the three path turning for home, also was going well at the end while well out in the strip. EVERY SUNDAY settled off the inside, lacked a kick in the drive. WILD REECE broke with the turn, turned in an even effort. STRIKE TEN off a step slow, raced back, came five wide out of the turn, improved position while never dangerous. DYNAPAC vied up front while closest to the inside, began to fade before a half. CAPTAIN SUNSHINE five then out to seven wide through the turn, not a threat. GRINDING retreated while racing toward the inside. ELI IS A GIANT dueled up front early, garnered a briefly larger lead far turn, gave way in the drive. LONOKE COUNTY off slow, never a factor in trailing throughout.
